MAY 24, 2023 - Agriculture in the Classroom NL (AITC-NL) would like to give a "thumbs up" to our Little Green Thumbs and our Little Green Sprouts classes on their successful gardens this year.

AITC-NL has 291 Little Green Thumbs/Sprouts classes in 119 schools participating in Harvest Celebrations in May and June. That's 4,350 Little Green Thumbs and 1,573 Little Green Sprouts students across Newfoundland and Labrador! Our Little Green Thumb classes have also successfully wiggled their way through another year of vermicomposting. We have thousands of very happy and healthy worms in Newfoundland and Labrador schools!

Students will be participating in Harvest Celebrations by visiting vegetable and dairy farms, hosting concerts for parents, grandparents and special guests, having a harvest feast with their crops, attending grocery store tours to learn about nutrition and healthy eating, visiting greenhouses, and planting and sharing the gift of their gardens!

This project was funded in part by the Canadian Agricultural Partnership, a five-year (2018-2023), \$3-billion investment by federal, provincial, and territorial governments to innovate, strengthen and grow Canada's agriculture and agri-foods sector. This included a \$2-billion commitment that was cost-shared 60% federally and 40% provincially/territorially for programs that were designed and delivered by provinces and territories. The Canadian Agricultural Partnership provided \$305,000 annually to support Agriculture in the Classroom NL activities in Newfoundland and Labrador. The Canadian Agricultural Partnership has been replaced by the Sustainable Canadian Agricultural Partnership, a new \$3.5-billion, 5-year agreement (2023-2028), between the federal, provincial and territorial governments to strengthen the competitiveness, innovation, and resiliency of the agriculture, agri-food and agri-based products sector.
