

"BEE Creative" Literacy Contest

Agriculture in the Classroom NL has partnered with the *NL Beekeeping Association* and *NL Eggs* to give students across Newfoundland and Labrador a chance to decorate a beehive in their school's name.

Classes can submit up to three of literary works that combines the student's literacy talent and skills with their knowledge of Agriculture in Newfoundland and Labrador (ex: poem, comic, story, etc). Contest runs April 12th to April 30th, 2021. The winners will be announced Tuesday, May 4th, 2021.

The winning classes get the opportunity to decorate the beehive anyway that they choose (school mascot, colors, etc.) Then, the beehive will be returned to the participating Beekeeper's farm where it will be taken care of in the name of your school/class.
